21 On August 6, 2010 a status conference was held in the above-captioned matter before the
22 Honorable Susan Illston, United States District Judge. At that court appearance, the Court set a
23 trial date of March 21, 2011, and a pretrial conference of March 1, 2011. Government counsel
24 and counsel for defendant Bonds agreed that the time between August 6, 2010 and March 21,
25 2011 should be excluded from the Speedy Trial Act pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3161(h)(7)(A) and
26 B(i), (ii) and (iv).

27 Based upon the representations made by the parties in open court on August 6, 2010, and
28 good cause appearing therefore,

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time between August 6, 2010 and March 21, 2011 be
2 excluded from the computation of the period within which the trial must commence for the
3 reasons and based upon the statutory provisions set forth above, and for those reasons proffered
4 by the parties in open court. Based upon the grounds set forth above, the Court finds that the
5 ends of justice outweigh the interests of the public and the parties in a speedier trial, and that
6 failure to grant such a continuance would likely result in a miscarriage of justice.
