HONORABLE PETER BERGER CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, 14 Defendant. 15 16 17 Before the Court is the complaint filed January 10, 2007 by plaintiff Le Roi Johnson 18 ("Johnson"), in which Johnson asserts, inter alia, civil rights claims against the Honorable 19 Peter Berger arising out of Judge Berger's imposition of a \$200 fine against plaintiff. 20 Where, as here, a case is brought in forma pauperis, the Court "shall dismiss the 21 case . . . if the court determines that . . . the action . . . seeks monetary relief against a 22 defendant who is immune from such relief." See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(iii). A state 23 judge is absolutely immune from civil liability for damages resulting from acts performed in 24 his judicial capacity. See Pierson v. Ray, 386 U.S. 547, 553-55 (1967). 25 Accordingly, the claims asserted against Judge Berger are hereby DISMISSED. 26 IT IS SO ORDERED. Yafine M. Chesney 27
