APPROVING PRODUCT BUNDLE
SHIPPING PROCEDURE FOR
CLAIMANTS WITH FOREIGN
ADDRESSES

10 Having duly considered Plaintiffs' stipulated motion of February 14, 2014, the motion
11 is GRANTED and the following is ORDERED:

- 12 • The Claims Administrator shall send a notice to all of the approximately 200
13 product claimants who have only provided foreign addresses.
- 14 • The notice will advise the claimants that product bundles will not be shipped to
15 a foreign address and therefore, if they want their bundle, they must provide a
16 U.S. shipping address.
- 17 • The U.S. address need not be the claimant's own. It may instead be the address
18 of a friend, relative, or other person to whom the bundle may be shipped.
- 19 • The notice will further advise that, if a U.S. address is not provided, the
20 claimant's bundle will be donated to [Goodwill Industries International, Inc.]
21 ~~[other charity selected by the Court].~~
