**NOTICE OF JOINDER IN STIPULATION  
 FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
 RESPOND TO COMPLAINT ; ORDER**

1 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Defendants Hitachi America, Ltd. (hereinafter "HAL") and  
2 Hitachi Electronic Devices (USA), Inc. (hereinafter "HED-US") have, by written notice to  
3 Plaintiff in this action, joined in the Stipulation for Extension of Time between Plaintiff and  
4 defendant AU Optronics Corporation America dated and filed in this action on February 6, 2007  
5 and currently awaiting approval by the Court (the "Stipulation").

6 Pursuant to the Stipulation, the deadline for HAL and HED-US to respond to Plaintiff's  
7 Complaint shall be extended until the earlier of the following two dates: (1) forty-five days after  
8 the filing of a Consolidated Amended Complaint in the LCD Cases; or (2) forty-five days after  
9 Plaintiff provides written notice to Defendants that it does not intend to file a Consolidated  
10 Amended Complaint, provided that such notice may be given only after the initial case  
11 management conference in the MDL transferee court in this case. The joinder in the Stipulation  
12 does not constitute a waiver by HAL and HED-US of any defense, including but not limited to  
13 the defenses of lack of personal or subject matter jurisdiction, insufficiency of process,  
14 insufficiency of service of process, or improper venue.
