Defendant is hereby advised that if it fails in the future to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Order to provide chambers copies of electronically-filed

documents, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the record any electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to the Court.
