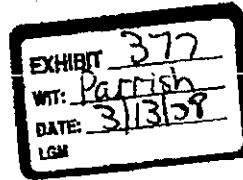

Bernie Parrish will run for Executive Director of the NFLPA on the following platform: (Provided it will not adversely affect our class action suit against the NFLPA and Players Inc) When elected the Executive Director will name _____ Assistant Executive Director.

1. Pay \$6 million of Executive Directors compensation to a Dire Needs program. Pay Parrish the same salary as President G.W. Bush for a 3 year term.
2. Institute 3 year term limits for Exec Dir and Retirement Plan trustees
3. Fire the Groom Law Group that law firm that created today's disability plan fiasco, separate disability plan from retirement plan.
4. Rewrite disability plan to fit professional football.
5. Reduce union dues by 50%.
6. Demand the missing 17% (\$1.2 Billion) from the owners, the players actually only get less than 43% although they are told they get 60%.
7. Will Match Major League Baseball's retirement plan for all retired players.
8. Fire the \$2 million a year legal staff use half that money for Dire Needs families
9. Fire Tom Condon, Dave Duerson, and Jeff Van Note from retirement board
10. Reinstate 3 year terms for retirement board members
11. Fire Scandal Manager Larry Davis
12. No more Hawaii or any other extravagant meetings
13. Make transparent plain English accounting on all accounts, NFLPA, Players Inc, NFL Youth Football, PAT fund.
14. Expose and eliminate all secret "sideletters" from CBA
15. Give active and retired players NFLPA votes for life.
16. Set a policy to fire those who do not return phone calls within 24 hours.
