I told you for months exactly what I was doing. I kept you posted as I went through several Law firms to try to find the right ones who would not only represent us well but take our case on a contingent basis.

I told you exactly what my plan was because I believed and am even more convinced now it is the only way to get justice for all our 3500 brothers and their families.

I told you I believed that a law suit was the only way to deal with the profiteers who control the NFLPA. I believed that it should be an anti-trust suit or suit against the Retirement Plan and those will come next and feed off the information that will come to light during our class action suit against Players Inc.

I've told you every step of the way what I was doing and I told you I cannot and will not make one dime off the financial misery of the 100's perhaps a couple thousand retired players and their families who have been harmed by Gene Upshaw.

I told you about the congressional committee's I have been working with to bring about hearings and investigations and by God I have those coming too.

I am not trying to form a fraternity or a social organization. Meeting with Upshaw would be to show a deference to a racketeer.

I told you about pressuring the Dept of Labor, the Justice Department, and the NLRB, and the attorney Generals from the 3 states who made the \$190 million restitution deal with Chicago Bears Patrick Ryan, Aon Corp. I didn't see anybody offer to help me go after Ryan a major fund raiser for Bush all I heard was Pyle kissing his ass and justifying his conflicts of interest.

Ryan has sold in recent months over \$94 million of his Aon stock which began the year at 22,000,000 shares at the beginning of the year.
