13 14	Upon review and consideration of the Settlement Agreement dated as of June 5, 2009,			
15	and the Amendment to the Settlement Agreement dated August 4, 2009, executed on behalf of			
16	Plaintiffs and the Class (as defined) by Class Counsel, and on behalf of Defendants The National			
17	Football League Players Association ("NFLPA") and The National Football League Players, Inc.			
18	("Players, Inc.") (collectively "the Defendants") by their counsel, and the exhibits attached

9	reasonably practicable, and in all events, within 20 days of the date of this Order.				
10	4. Prior to the Settlement Hearing, Class Counsel and Defendants' Counsel shall				
11	serve and file a sworn statement attesting to compliance with the provisions of paragraphs 2 and				
12	3 of this Order.				
13 14	5. The actions set forth in paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Order are hereby found to be				
14	reasonably calculated to provide direct notice to all Class Members and, when completed, shall				
16	constitute due and sufficient notice of the proposed settlement and the Settlement Hearing to all				
17	persons affected by and/or entitled to participate in the settlement, in full compliance with the				
18	notice requirements of Fed. R. Civ. P. 23 and due process.
