2. What is the problem or deficiency in existing law that this bill seeks to remedy?

The problem with current law is that in order to bring a civil suit the violator must first be convicted criminally under 502. Most prosecutors are unable to bring successful 502 claims for a variety of reasons including lack of training, funds or an understanding of the technology. As a result, there is no way for companies to bring an action themselves. By removing the prior criminal conviction requirement and authorizing injunctive relief it provides companies with a means of protecting themselves from attack when prosecutors are unable or unwilling to do so. Additionally, it makes it easier for a prosecutor to later bring a successful criminal complaint because the prior civil suit will be part of the public record.
