Before the Court is petitioner David McDonough's Motion for Certificate of Appealability, filed October 21, 2011. Having read and considered petitioner's motion, the Court finds petitioner is entitled to a certificate of appealability on the following issue: whether it is a violation of the Ex Post Facto Clause, U.S. Const. art.
