Upon consideration of the parties' briefing regarding which motion should be adjudicated 18 first, the Court determines that it will adjudicate Defendant's motion to dismiss or, in the 19 alternative, for summary judgment first. Therefore, the Court authorizes Defendant to re-notice 20 the motion.
