1 WHEREAS, on October 31, 2008, plaintiff filed a Motion for Class Certification and an
2 Application for Preliminary Injunction to Prohibit Recasting and Foreclosure on ARM Loans
3 (“plaintiff’s motions”);

4 WHEREAS, defendants Paul Financial LLC’s and HSBC Bank USA, N.A.’s (1) Response to
5 Plaintiff’s Motion for Class Certification, and (2) Response to Plaintiff’s Application for Preliminary
6 Injunction to Prohibit Recasting and Foreclosure on ARM Loans, are currently due December 30,
7 2008, and a hearing is currently scheduled on plaintiff’s motions for January 20, 2009;

9 WHEREAS, in addition to filing their (1) Response to Plaintiff’s Motion for Class
10 Certification, and (2) Response to Plaintiff’s Application for Preliminary Injunction to Prohibit
11 Recasting and Foreclosure on ARM Loans, defendants Paul Financial LLC and HSBC Bank USA,
12 N.A. (“defendants”) intend to file a separate Motion for Summary Judgment on plaintiff’s individual
13 claims on December 30, 2008 as well;

15 WHEREAS, for the sake of efficiency, defendants Paul Financial LLC and HSBC Bank
16 USA, N.A. wish to file joint memoranda for each of the three distinct motions their counsel is
17 responding to and/or filing. As a result, defendants seek an enlargement of the page limit, from 25

2 for plaintiff's replies to defendants' (1) Response to Plaintiff's Motion for Class Certification, and
3 (2) Response to Plaintiff's Application for Preliminary Injunction to Prohibit Recasting and
4 Foreclosure on ARM Loans, and defendants' reply in support of its motion for summary judgment,
5 should be enlarged up to 25 pages each;

7 WHEREAS, the parties have agreed that the 25-page limitation set forth in Local Rule 7-4(b)
8 for plaintiff's Response to Defendants Motion for Summary Judgment should be enlarged up to 40
9 pages; and

10 WHEREFORE, the parties hereby stipulate and agree that the 25-page limitation set forth in
11 Local Rule 7-4(b) for their responsive briefs should be enlarged up to 40 pages each (exclusive of
12 table of contents, table of authorities, and supporting declarations and exhibits), and the 15-page
13 limitation for the parties' reply briefs should be enlarged to 25 pages.
