**ORDER CLARIFYING BRIEFING

On March 14, 2012, Defendant James Yu filed a motion to set aside the judgment in this case and noticed it for hearing on April 27, 2012. Because that date was not available for hearings, Defendant re-filed the motion on March 15, 2012 and set it for hearing on May 25, 2012. However, Defendant did not correctly enter the dates on which the opposition and reply briefs are due. The Court issues this Order to clarify the correct briefing schedule.
