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17 On October 3, 2007, petitioner, a California prisoner proceeding pro se, filed the
18 above-titled petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On January
19 30, 2012, the petition was denied on its merits, and a certificate of appealability ("COA")
20 was denied. On February 22, 2012, petitioner filed a request for a 90-day extension of time
21 in which to file a notice of appeal and application for a COA.

22 Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 4(a) allows for an extension of time to appeal if
23 the party requests such relief within thirty days of the expiration of the time to file the notice
24 and shows excusable neglect or good cause. See Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(5). The extension
25 must be to a date no more than thirty days after the original deadline, or fourteen days after
26 the entry of the order granting the motion, whichever is later. See id


27 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, petitioner's motion for an extension of time to file a
28 notice of appeal and application for a COA is hereby GRANTED. Petitioner shall file the

1 notice of appeal and said application no later than March 30, 2012.

2 This order terminates Docket No. 19.
