FILE COMPLAINT UNDER SEAL**



14 Plaintiff has moved to file a complete version of his complaint under seal. The Court previously  
15 indicated that this would be inappropriate because the entire basis for plaintiff's disability claim would  
16 be inaccessible to the public, and now finds that plaintiff has not demonstrated good cause to file his  
17 complaint under seal. Accordingly, the motion to file under seal is DENIED [Docket No. 119] and  
18 plaintiff may pursue one of two options. He may either publicly file a complete version of his  
19 complaint, or may consider voluntarily dismissing his case and refile it as an anonymous "Doe"  
20 plaintiff. If plaintiff intends to file a complete version of his complaint publicly, he must do so on or  
21 before September 19, 2008.
