1 WHEREAS, Plaintiff E&M Trust (“Plaintiff”) filed its complaint *pro se* in the above-  
2 captioned case on December 5, 2007;

3 WHEREAS, on December 28, 2007, defendant ABN AMRO Bank, N.A. (“ABN  
4 AMRO”) filed a motion to enlarge time to respond to the complaint because ABN AMRO’s counsel had  
5 been unsuccessful in contacting Plaintiff to secure its agreement to an extension;

6 WHEREAS, on January 2, 2008, the Court issued an Order to Show Cause requiring  
7 Plaintiff to explain why the case should not be dismissed for non-compliance with the Civil Local Rule  
8 requiring a corporation to appear only through legal counsel, or, in the alternative, requiring Plaintiff to  
9 retain counsel, and staying the case pending resolution of the issue;

10 WHEREAS, on January 25, 2008, Plaintiff filed a notice of appearance of counsel;

11 WHEREAS, on January 28, 2008, the Court discharged the Order to show cause and  
12 lifted the stay;

13 WHEREAS Plaintiff’s counsel has agreed to extend the time in which ABN AMRO may  
14 answer, move, cross-complain or otherwise respond to Plaintiff’s complaint through **March 31, 2008**;  
15 and

17 WHEREAS no prior extensions have been granted for the time in which ABN AMRO  
18 could answer, move, cross-complain or otherwise respond to Plaintiff’s complaint;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

20 1. ABN AMRO’s time to answer, move, cross-complain or otherwise respond to the  
21 complaint is hereby extended through **March 31, 2008**.

22 IT IS SO ORDERED.
