**ORDER DIRECTING DEFENDANTS
ROBERT OLINS AND ARGYLE CAPITAL
MANAGEMENT CORP. TO LODGE
CHAMBERS COPIES IN COMPLIANCE
WITH GENERAL ORDER 45 AND THE
COURT'S STANDING ORDERS**


On September 11, 2009, defendants Robert Olins and Argyle Capital Management Corp. filed opposition to plaintiff's motion for partial summary judgment, and on September 25, 2009, filed a motion for partial summary judgment on defendants' behalf. Defendants have violated General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Orders, however, by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than noon on the business day following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one paper copy of each document that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly marked with the judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File.'" See General Order 45 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders For Civil Cases Assigned to The Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.

Defendants are hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Orders by immediately submitting chambers copies of the above-referenced

1 documents. Defendants are hereby advised that if they fail in the future to comply with
2 General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Order to provide chambers copies of
3 electronically-filed documents, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited
4 to, striking from the record any electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has
5 not been timely provided to the Court.
