13 On January 16, 2009, the Court ordered Plaintiffs in the above-captioned matter to file a
14 motion for default judgment within 30 days. (Dkt. #17.) As no motion had been filed, the Court
15 subsequently ordered Plaintiffs to file a status report by March 9, 2009. (Dkt. #19.) Plaintiffs have
16 failed to comply with this order as well. The Court notes that this is part of a repeated pattern on
17 Plaintiffs' part of failing to comply with court deadlines and failing to prosecute their case in general.
18 (*See, e.g.* Dkt. ## 3, 10.)

19 Accordingly, the Court hereby ORDERS Plaintiffs to show cause why this case should not be
20 dismissed for failure to prosecute and comply with court deadlines. Plaintiffs shall file a declaration
21 by March 26, 2009, and the Court shall conduct a hearing on April 2, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in
22 Courtroom B, 15th Floor, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, California.
