20 Pursuant to Local Rules 16-2(d) and 7-12, Plaintiff Jeffrey E. Walker and Defendants  
21 stipulate and jointly request a continuance of the Case Management Conference (“CMC”) in this

27 mediation proceeding, currently scheduled for September 4, 2012. Dkt. No. 185.

This will allow the parties to continue with additional discovery and, thereafter, participate in additional mediation proceedings with the goal of resolving the dispute without further judicial assistance, obviating the Conference.
