The Court agreed to allow the defendants until December 3, 2009, to produce evidence of 25 26 payments which had not been credited against their tax liabilities. 27 For the foregoing reasons, it is hereby ORDERED that the hearing on the United States' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is continued to December 3, 2009, at 10:00 a.m.
