17 On February 26, 2009, plaintiffs electronically filed their Second Amended
18 Complaint. Plaintiffs have violated General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Orders,
19 however, by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than noon on the business day
20 following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one paper copy of each document
21 that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly marked with the
22 judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File.'" See General Order 45
23 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders for Civil Cases Assigned to the Honorable Maxine M.
24 Chesney ¶ 2.

25 Plaintiffs are hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's
26 Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced
27 document.

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1 The Court has previously advised plaintiffs of their failure to comply with General
2 Order 45 and the Court's Standing Order in connection with earlier-filed documents. (See
3 Order, filed June 24, 2008.) Such reminder appears to have had little to no effect on
4 compelling compliance therewith.

5 Parties are expected to comply with court rules without repeated reminders.
6 Accordingly, plaintiffs are hereby advised that the Court will impose sanctions, including,
7 but not limited to, striking from the record any electronically-filed document of which a
8 chambers copy has not been timely provided to the Court.
