Plaintiffs' motion for class certification was filed on June 18, 2010. In accordance with the schedule agreed upon at the June 4, 2010, defendants' opposition to the motion is due to be filed on July 2, and the motion is scheduled for oral argument on July 30. To the extent plaintiffs have raised claims in their certification motion that were not included in their complaint, defendants may argue this point in their opposition and/or make a motion to strike.
