Defendant is hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced document.

The Court has previously advised defendant of its failure to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Order in connection with earlier-filed documents. (See Order, filed July 1, 2008.) Such reminder appears to have had little to no effect on compelling compliance therewith.
