TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL OF RECORD:

The above-captioned case was referred to Magistrate Judge Maria-Elena James to prepare a report and recommendation on Plaintiff's pending Motion for Default Judgment. Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 7, Defendants shall file any opposition to Plaintiff's motion by January 8, 2009, and Plaintiff shall file any reply by January 15. If Defendants do not file an opposition, Plaintiff shall file detailed proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, which shall address the factors in *Eitel v. McCool*, 782 F.2d 1470, 1471-72 (9th Cir. 1986), by January 15.

When filing papers that require the Court to take any action (e.g. motions, meet and confer letters, administrative requests), the parties shall, in addition to filing papers electronically, lodge

1 with chambers a printed copy of the papers by noon of the next court day following the day the
2 papers are filed electronically. These printed copies shall be marked "Chambers Copy" and shall be
3 submitted to the Clerk's Office, in an envelope clearly marked with "Magistrate Judge James," the
4 case number and "E-Filing Chambers Copy." Parties shall not file a paper copy of any document
5 with the Clerk's Office that has already been filed electronically.

6 Plaintiff shall serve this order upon all other parties in this action. Please contact the
