 20 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED between the parties that the currently set case

1 this stayed civil matter until the conclusion of the criminal case involving three of the six named
2 Plaintiffs in this matter, especially since this matter should remain stayed until following that
3 criminal trial per prior order of the Court.

5 to August 11, 2010, or another date thereafter per the Court's availability, at 10:30 a.m. in Your
