6 Plaintiff should be prepared to prove its damages by 7 competent testimony or other admissible evidence. If 8 plaintiff intends to prove damages by affidavits or 9 declarations, the affiant or declarant should have personal knowledge of all matters to which she testifies. For all 10 evidence, proper foundations must be established. For an 11 12 explanation of the evidentiary requirements for proving 13 damages in a default case, the parties are encouraged to consult Chapter Six of Civil Procedure Before Trial by William 14 15 W. Schwarzer, A. Wallace Tashima, and James M. Wagstaffe.

Defendant should attend the hearing if it contests the validity or amount of plaintiff's claim. Seven days before the hearing, on Wednesday, December 10, 2008, plaintiff shall file a declaration setting forth in detail all steps taken to serve defendant with notice of this hearing.
