19	On November 26, 2008, lead plaintiffs filed an amended class action complaint and,
20	pursuant to Civil Local Rule 79-5(d), an administrative motion to file certain portions of the
21	amended complaint under seal. The sealing request is based on defendants' designation of
22	documents referenced in the complaint as confidential pursuant to a stipulated protective order.
23	Defendants filed a response declaration, as required by Civil Local Rule 79-5(d), stating that the
24 25	designated material is sealable because it reveals confidential business information such as the
23 26	identity of business partners, financial and strategic arrangements with those partners,
20 27	confidential regulatory communications, and negotiations and pricing strategies that could harm
28	defendants' competitive position if revealed.
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United States District Court For the Northern District of California Defendants' declaration establishes that the designated information is properly sealable as confidential business information. Therefore, the designated portions of the amended complaint shall be filed under seal.
