16 On June 23, 2009, plaintiff Continental D.I.A. Diamond Products, Inc. filed a letter brief seeking  
17 the Court's intervention in a discovery dispute. Plaintiff contends that defendants have either failed to  
18 respond or have provided incomplete responses to plaintiff's first set of interrogatories and second  
19 request for production. Plaintiff propounded these requests on April 16, 2009 and now seeks an order  
20 compelling defendants to comply with their discovery obligations. Defendants have not filed an  
21 opposition to plaintiff's motion.

22 Plaintiff's discovery requests seek basic information about the parties' claims and counterclaims.  
23 In light of defendants' failure to oppose plaintiff's motion, the Court sees no reason why the motion  
24 should not be granted. It is especially important for defendants to provide this information promptly  
25 as fact discovery is set to close on September 28, 2009. *See* Docket No. 99. Accordingly, the Court  
26 orders defendants to provide complete responses to plaintiff's first set of interrogatories and to produce  
27 documents responsive to plaintiff's second request for documents by **July 24, 2009**. Failure to comply  
28 with this deadline will cause the Court to consider whether sanctions are warranted under Federal Rule

1 of Civil Procedure 37(b).


