WHEREAS, on January 15, 2009 the Court entered an order staying the case and moving the

counterclaims, this extension is not for the purpose of delay, and the parties believe that this short
extension of time will not effect any dates and other deadlines that have been set by the Court due to
the current stay imposed by the Court and is in the interests of justice. (see Declaration of Jeffrey M.
Ratinoff filed herewith);
