When the court has not set a different briefing schedule, the 15 parties must comply with the deadlines in the Local Rules. Under Northern District of California 16 Local Rule 7-3(a), "[t]he opposition must be filed and served not more than 14 days after the 17 motion was filed." Plaintiffs missed the deadline to file their opposition to the motion to dismiss. 18 In the interest of justice, the court will once again excuse the failure to comply with the local 19 rules because the plaintiffs are proceeding pro se. However, the court has repeatedly warned 20 plaintiffs of the need to comply with court orders and local rules, see Docket # 67 at 2-3, and 21 will not further warn them. The court now sets the following new briefing schedule on the 22 motion to dismiss: Plaintiffs must file and serve their opposition to the motion to dismiss no later 23 than February 3, 2014. Defendants must file and serve their reply (if any) no later than 24 February 12, 2014. The hearing scheduled for February 28, 2014 for defendants' motion to 25

dismiss is now VACATED. The court will decide the matter on the parties' written submissions.
