1 Plaintiff submits the declarations of Class Counsel and the Settlement Administrator
2 in accordance with the Court's Order Approving Supplemental Distribution and Allocation
3 of Cy Pres Funds (ECF Doc. No. 136).

4 The Court granted final approval of the parties' settlement agreement on January 19,
5 2011, and has since then been supervising the distribution of the Fund to the settlement class
6 members. On August 31, 2011, the Court entered the above Order, which provides that:

7 If more than \$10,000 remains in residue upon completion of this
8 supplemental distribution, Plaintiff and Rust Consulting shall file
9 declarations apprising the Court of the current state of the Settlement Fund.
10 If less than \$10,000 remains, this residue shall be distributed in equal
11 shares to the National Consumer Law Center and Healthcare and Elder
12 Law Programs Corporation as cy pres beneficiaries.

13 As set forth in the Declarations of Class Counsel Nance F. Becker and Settlement
14 Administrator Kimberly Ness filed herewith, following the second distribution approved by
15 the Court, there is a balance of \$ 32,555.44 in the Settlement Fund. Plaintiff, accordingly,
16 renews her request that, based on their demonstrated commitment to advocating for the rights
17 of senior citizen consumers, including but not limited to protection against financial abuses,
18 NCLC and H.E.L.P. again be approved as the recipients of the *cy pres* funds in this matter,
19 and the Court authorize the distribution of the funds to those organizations in equal shares
20 forthwith.
