9 FURTHER CASE MANAGEMENT: February 27, 2009 at 2:30 p.m.

Parties **SHALL** conform to Rule 26(a)(2).

13 EXPERT DISCOVERY CUTOFF is August 3, 2009.

14 DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS **SHALL** be filed by August 7, 2009;

15 Opp. Due August 21, 2009; Reply Due August 28, 2009;

16 and set for hearing no later than September 11, 2009 at 9:00 AM.

17 PRETRIAL CONFERENCE DATE: October 13, 2009 at 3:30 PM.

18 JURY TRIAL DATE: November 2, 2009 at 8:30 AM,

19 Courtroom 10, 19th floor.

20 TRIAL LENGTH is estimated to be five days.

21 SPECIAL DISCOVERY AND PRETRIAL PROVISIONS:

22 By November 13, 2008, counsel shall inform the Court if the case shall be referred to the mediation
23 program or to a magistrate-judge for settlement purposes. The ADR process shall be completed by
February 13, 2009.

24 The pretrial conference **SHALL** be attended by trial counsel prepared to discuss all aspects of the case,
including settlement. Parties **SHALL** conform to the attached instructions. Plaintiff is **ORDERED** to
25 serve a copy of this order on any party subsequently joined in this action.
