**ORDER RE LETTER REPORT FILED
BY COUNSEL FOR DEFENDANTS**

The court is in receipt of the letter filed by counsel for Defendants Andrew Stroud and Stroud Productions and Enterprises, Inc., reporting on her visit to her client Stroud's residence in compliance with the court's orders to assist him in identifying and producing additional recordings in his possession.
