17 On January 6, 2009, plaintiff filed eight proofs of service of process. Plaintiff has

20 are filed electronically, one paper copy of each document that is filed electronically . . .  
21 marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly marked with the judge's name, case number, and  
22 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File.'" See General Order 45 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders  
23 For Civil Cases Assigned to The Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.

24 Plaintiff is hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's  
25 Standing Orders by immediately submitting chambers copies of the above-referenced  
26 documents.


27 The Court has previously advised plaintiff of her failure to comply with General Order  
28 45 and the Court's Standing Order in connection with earlier-filed documents. (See Order

1 filed Dec. 4, 2008.) Such reminder appears to have had little to no effect on compelling  
2 compliance therewith.

3 Parties are expected to comply with court rules without repeated reminders.  
4 Accordingly, plaintiff is hereby advised that the Court will impose sanctions, including, but  
5 not limited to, striking from the record any electronically-filed document of which a  
6 chambers copy has not been timely provided to the Court.
