WHEREAS all previous time modifications in this case have related to: (1) the time for filing responsive pleadings; (2) the continuance of the initial Case Management Conference; (3) the hearing and briefing schedule on TVS's Rule 12 motions; (4) the exchange of infringement and invalidity contentions and proposed terms for construction; and (5) the deadline to complete mediation.
