**ORDER DIRECTING DEFENDANT  
BIOLITEC, INC. TO SUBMIT CHAMBERS  
COPY IN COMPLIANCE WITH GENERAL  
ORDER 45 AND THE COURT'S  
STANDING ORDERS**

18 On September 2, 2008, defendant Biolitec, Inc. electronically filed its answer to  
19 plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint. Defendant has violated General Order 45 and the  
20 Court's Standing Orders, however, by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than  
21 noon on the business day following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one  
22 paper copy of each document that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and  
23 . . . clearly marked with the judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not  
24 File.'" See General Order 45 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders for Civil Cases Assigned to  
25 the Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.

26 Defendant is hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's  
27 Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced  
28 document. Defendant is hereby advised that if it fails in the future to comply with the

1 Court's Standing Order to provide a chambers copy of each electronically-filed document,  
2 the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the record any  
3 electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to the  
4 Court.
