

14 DECLARATION OF COUNSEL

15 R. Scott Erlewine declares:

16 1. I am a partner with Phillips, Erlewine & Given LLP, counsel for defendant
17 National Railroad Passenger Corporation d/b/a Amtrak ("Amtrak") in this case. The matters
18 stated in this declaration are based upon my personal knowledge.

19 2. The court has assigned this case to mediation, which was originally scheduled to
20 occur on February 23, 2009. In order to provide sufficient time for an exchange of informal
21 discovery, the mediation has been rescheduled to March 23, 2009.

22 3. Amtrak has pending a Motion to Dismiss the Sixth Claim For Relief in plaintiff's
23 Second Amended Complaint, which is currently scheduled for hearing on March 27, 2009.

24 4. In order to avoid the time and expense of plaintiff having to respond to Amtrak's
25 pending motion to dismiss prior to the mediation, the parties hereby request that the hearing on
26 the pending motion be continued to April 24, with the deadlines to file opposition and reply
27 papers corresponding to the new hearing date.


28 5. There has been one prior continuance of the hearing on the pending motion to
dismiss, which was made to accommodate the first mediation date. The requested further

1 continuance is to accommodate the re-scheduled mediation date.

2 6. The requested continuance will not affect the scheduling of this case. The court
3 has set this matter for trial on November 2, 2009 and set a further case management conference
4 on April 24, 2009.
