The court warned plaintiff that 19 failure to file a proper amended complaint within 30 days would result in the 20 dismissal of this action. 21 More than 40 days have elapsed; however, plaintiff has not filed an 22 amended complaint or sought an extension of time to do so. The action is 23 DISMISSED.
