Defendant is hereby advised that if it fails in the future to comply with the Court's order to provide chambers copies of electronically-filed documents, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the record any electronicallyfiled document of which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to the Court.
