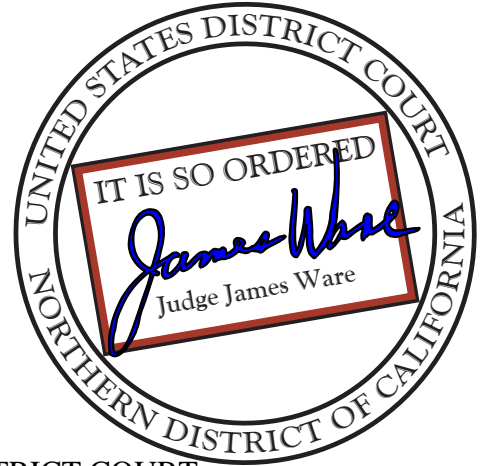

26 submitted at the trial:


