**ORDER DIRECTING DEFENDANT
CHASE BANK USA, N.A. TO LODGE
CHAMBERS COPIES IN COMPLIANCE
WITH GENERAL ORDER 45 AND THE
COURT'S STANDING ORDERS**


On September 15, 2008, defendant Chase Bank USA, N.A. ("Chase") filed an answer and counterclaim. Chase has violated General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Orders, however, by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than noon on the business day following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one paper copy of each document that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly marked with the judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File.'" See General Order 45 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders For Civil Cases Assigned to The Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.

Chase is hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced documents. Chase is hereby advised that if it fails in the future to comply with the Court's Standing Order to provide chambers copies of electronically-filed documents, the Court

1 may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the record any
2 electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to the
3 Court.
