

On December 28, 2008, plaintiff filed an Answer to defendant Chase Bank USA, 17 N.A.'s Counterclaim. Plaintiff has violated General Order 45 and the Court's Standing 18 19 Orders, however, by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than noon on the 20 business day following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one paper copy of 21 each document that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly marked with the judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File." See 22 23 General Order 45 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders For Civil Cases Assigned to The 24 Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.

Plaintiff is hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's
Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced
document. Plaintiff is hereby advised that if she fails in the future to comply with General
Order 45 and the Court's Standing Order to provide chambers copies of electronically-filed

1	documents, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the
2	record any electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has not been timely
3	provided to the Court.
