

On September 12, 2008, defendant filed a memorandum showing cause why the 17 action should not be remanded. Defendant has violated General Order 45 and the Court's 18 19 Standing Orders, however, by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than noon on 20 the business day following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one paper copy 21 of each document that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly 22 marked with the judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File." See 23 General Order 45 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders For Civil Cases Assigned to The 24 Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.

Defendant is hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's
Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of its memorandum and any
accompanying declarations and exhibits. Defendant is hereby advised that if it fails in the
future to comply with the Court's Standing Order to provide chambers copies of

1	electronically-filed documents, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited
2	to, striking from the record any electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has
3	not been timely provided to the Court.
