ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF JUDGMENT

On May 20, 2010, the Court entered judgment against defendant M.O.C.A. Residential Facilities, Inc., doing business as Clinton Village Convalescent Hospital ("M.O.C.A"), in the amount of \$75,303.47. Dkt. No. 74. M.O.C.A. never appeared in the action nor was it ever represented by counsel in the action. Id. On May 18, 2020, plaintiffs brought the instant application for renewal of judgment because they have never recovered any of the money pursuant to the Court's judgment. Dkt. No. 77.
