12	This case was opened when plaintiff wrote to this court asking for assistance in
13	obtaining a transfer from Pleasant Valley State Prison to another prison for medical reasons. In
14	an effort to protect plaintiff's rights, it was treated as an attempt to open a new case. The filing
15	was directed to the attention of Judge Saundra Brown Armstrong, but he does not say why he so
16	addressed it, and Judge Armstrong is not presiding over any case involving Pleasant Valley
17	State Prison, which is in the Eastern District. As a result the case was randomly assigned to the
18	undersigned.
19	Construing the filing as a civil rights complaint, the acts complained of occurred at
20	Pleasant Valley State Prison, which lies within the venue of the United States District Court for
21	the Eastern District of California. Presumably any appropriate defendants would reside in that
22	district as well. Venue, therefore, properly lies in that district and not in this one. See 28
23	U.S.C. § 1391(b). This case is Transferred to the United States District Court for the
24	Eastern District of California. See 28 U.S.C. § 1406(a). In view of the transfer, the Court will
25	not rule upon plaintiff's request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis.
