
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1 The parties to this action hereby stipulate as follows:

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2 From the date of entry of the Court's order on this stipulation, and going forward, the title of this action shall be: "In re Nuveen Funds/City of Alameda Securities Litigation." Further, the 3 Court and the parties shall refer to the Nuveen-affiliated parties as "plaintiffs" and the Alameda-4 affiliated parties and Stone & Youngberg as "defendants." The Court and the parties shall treat 5 Nuveen's First Amended Counterclaim as the operative complaint in this action. As plaintiffs, the 6 Nuveen-affiliated parties shall have the burden of proof on all of their claims and, unless the Court 7 orders otherwise, shall at the trial of this matter present their opening statement and their case-in-8 9 chief first, and their closing argument first and last.
