Pending before the Court is Defendants City of Alameda and Police Chief Walter Tibbet's Motion to Dismiss. (Dkt. #10.) The Court notes that this matter is also scheduled for a Case Management Conference on April 2, 2009. Accordingly, the Court reminds all parties that they must file magistrate judge jurisdiction consent/declination forms by March 26, 2009, and Defendants City of Alameda and Police Chief Walter Tibbet are required to file their forms at the time of filing a motion to dismiss.

This civil case was randomly assigned to United States Magistrate Judge Maria-Elena James for all purposes including trial. In accordance with Title 28, U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this District Court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including a jury or non-jury trial, and to order the entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and disposition. Accordingly, the parties shall inform the Court whether they consent to Magistrate

1 Judge James' jurisdiction or request reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy
2 of both the consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's
3 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left
4 margin, then choose "Civil." Plaintiffs may also use the enclosed form. The parties shall inform the
5 Court by March 26, 2009.
