The hearing on both motions is scheduled for 18 December 18, 2008. Defendants filed an emergency motion to extend the deadline for their 19 reply brief in support of their motion to dismiss from December 4 to December 8. Plaintiff did 20 not serve or e-file his opposition to the motion, defendants explain, but instead simply mailed it 21 to defendants over Thanksgiving weekend. Defendants did not receive the opposition until 22 December 1, and defendants' reply brief is due three days later. Defendants indicate that they 23 attempted promptly to contact plaintiff and, just today, plaintiff indicated that he does not 24 oppose the extension. Good cause for the extension having been shown, the requested 25


extension is **GRANTED**, and defendants' reply brief is due December 8, 2008.
