This <u>pro se</u> civil rights action was filed on November 4, 2008, at which time the court notified plaintiff in writing that the action was deficient due to the failure to pay the filing fee or furnish a completed and signed court-approved <u>in forma pauperis</u> application – specifically that he had not used the right form and had not attached a copy of his trust account statement for the last six months. Plaintiff was advised that failure to pay the fee or file the application materials within thirty days would result in dismissal of the action. Plaintiff did not pay the filing fee or submit the trust account statement materials needed to complete his <u>in forma pauperis</u> application. The action is DISMISSED without prejudice for failure to pay the filing fee or submit a completed <u>in forma pauperis</u> application. Plaintiff may file a new action, but should include a filing fee or an <u>in forma pauperis</u> application with a new complaint to commence that new action. The clerk shall close the file.
