19 Pending before the Court is Defendant's Motion to Dismiss. Upon review of the record in  
20 this action, the Court notes that the parties have not filed written consents to Magistrate Judge  
21 James' jurisdiction or requests for reassignment to a United States District Court judge for trial. This  
22 civil case was randomly assigned to United States Magistrate Judge Maria-Elena James for all  
23 purposes including trial. In accordance with Title 28, U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this  
24 District Court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including a jury or  
25 non-jury trial, and to order the entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal  
26 from a judgment entered by Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court  
27 of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a  
28 district court.

1           You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and  
2 disposition. Accordingly, the parties shall inform the Court whether they consent to Magistrate  
3 Judge James' jurisdiction or request reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy  
4 of both the consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's  
5 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left  
6 margin, then choose "Civil." The parties shall inform the Court as soon as possible, but no later than  
7 December 18, 2008.
